The NW Retired Council has come up with the following strategy. This is not to be a static list but a foundation to be built on in the future.

- Produce regional newsletter twice yearly
- Organise the NW Retired Members Forums
- Set up Regional training courses/workshops for Retired Members
- Work with branches in setting up Branch Retired Sections with a view to increase the number of active sections within the Region
- Update website page on the Regional site for the North West Regional Retired Members
- Continue to work with Head Office and Branches on recruitment initiatives to increase numbers of retired members in the NW
- Support TUC/NPC/CWU campaigns: I.e. Raising Basic State Pension and Restoration of the Link and Improving Health Care
- Raise political awareness with retired members in the region and encourage CWU retired members to become more active in campaigns affecting today's and future pensioners
- Interact with other Regional Committees i.e. Youth & Women regarding Pensions & Health Care for today's and future Retired Members
- Interact with other retired organisations i.e. trade unions
- Work closely with Anti-Fascist Groups
- High lighting the issues of retired people by utilising support networks and services available to retired members in our region
